Electors and others qualified to vote at town meeting are hereby warned of a Town Meeting for the Town of Canaan, Falls Village, Connecticut to be held at Lee H. Kellogg School, 47 Main Street on Monday, May 19, 2014 at 7:00 PM to act on the following:

1. Shall the Town of Canaan appropriate up to the sum of \$1,767,507 for general municipal purposes for fiscal year 2014-2015?
2. Shall the Town of Canaan appropriate up to the sum of \$1,876,474 for educational expenses at Lee H. Kellogg School for fiscal year 2014-2015?
3. Shall the Town of Canaan transfer up to \$20,000 from unexpended funds from the 2013-2014 municipal budget to the Fire Truck Reserve Account No. 51001405 in an amount of up to \$10,000 and the Truck Reserve Account No. 51001439 in an amount of up to \$10,000?
4. Shall the Town of Canaan transfer up to \$2500 from unexpended funds from the Planning and Zoning Commission's 2013-2014 budget/Series 1011 to the Planning and Zoning Reserve Account No. 51001431?
5. Shall the Town of Canaan transfer any unexpended funds from the 2013-2014 budget in Series 2001 Fire Commission to the Fire Truck Reserve Account No. 51001405?
6. Shall the Town of Canaan transfer any unexpended funds from the 2013-2014 budget in Series 1005 Board of Assessors to the Assessors Revaluation Reserve Fund No 51001380?

7. Shall the Town of Canaan transfer any unexpended funds from the Canaan Board of Education/Lee H. Kellogg School 2013-2014 budget at the rate of fifty percent (50%) to the Lee H. Kellogg Technology Reserve Account No 1703228155 and at the rate of fifty percent (50%) to the Lee H. Kellogg Capital Improvement Reserve Account No 1022305?
8. Shall the Town of Canaan close the LHK Floor Replacement Reserve Account No 1702725649 and transfer the balance to the General Fund?
9. Shall the Town of Canaan appropriate up to \$45,000 from the Lee H. Kellogg Technology Reserve Account No 1703228155 for the purpose of wireless installation and devices?
10. To receive, review and act on the Annual Auditor's Report for Fiscal Year 2012-2013
11. To receive, review and/or act upon the report of the offices of the Town of Canaan for Fiscal Year 2012-2013
12. Any other business to properly come before this meeting.
