All searching is executed at <u>WebTownHall.com</u>© Records and data are automatically refreshed overnight, so information is always current, and because public access to records is done through the IMAS, llc, dedicated server, there is no danger of corrupting or compromising the system.

Users can search for free and view & print documents for a subscription fee of \$ 4.99 per day, \$ 29.99 per month, \$ 170.94 semi annually and \$ 323.89 annually

With <u>WebTownHall.com</u>©, the public can efficiently access town records from any location, and execute any of these municipal functions on-line:

- animal licensing renewal, public, ACO and police inquiry
- vitals registry indexes and requests
- cemetery deeds and maps with driving directions and burial transit permits
- business licensing dba/certificates
- military discharges, aka DD214
- business licensing and municipal permits
- town documents, meeting minutes, agendas, boards, commissions, etc.
- remit tax, utility, permit, sticker payments; p&z application fees; park & rec registrations; and non-criminal offenses
